The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, heard from the Competitors' Representatives and the Drivers concerned, having examined (video) evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Session: Free Practice 2
Time (fact): 10:07
Fact: Alleged impeding Car 37 at the exit of T5
Offence: Alleged Breach of Article 31.4 of 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations
Decision: No further action
Reason: The incident took place at the exit of turn 5. Car 13 was closely followed by Car 7, and both moved off the racing line at turn 5 to allow Car 11, who was on a fast lap, to pass. Shortly thereafter, at the exit of turn 5, Car 37 approached at high speed and had to abort his lap due to Car 7 and Car 13 being in his line. During the hearing, the driver of Car 37 informed the Stewards that, in his opinion, Car 13 did not dangerously impede him. Several cars were involved in this incident, which contributed to the confusion on track. Considering all these factors, the Stewards determined that this incident, which occurred during free practice, did not meet the threshold to warrant a penalty.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
