The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Technical Delegate, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 9 / Mitch Evans

Competitor: Jaguar TCS Racing

Session: After Free Practice 2

Fact: The Stewards received a report from the FIA Technical Delegate stating the following:

The car 9 performed a power cycle. Due to this power cycle, the car system lost the reference atmospheric pressure that is transmitted through the timing loops. Due to the fact the car 9 was in the box, it picked up tyre mounted on the car but also the spare tyre, and the values were alternating on our screen, which wrongly lead us to think that the atmospheric pressure was correctly reference.

So, the values contained in the initial Technical Report 8 to the Stewards were wrong. The system will be updated to avoid similiar error in the future.

Decision: The Stewards review the Decision N° 12 and instead take no further action regarding this case.

Reason: In accordance with Article 14.1.2 of the FIA International Sporting Code, the Stewards decided to re-examine their Decision N° 12. Indeed, after taking Decision 12 on the basis of the FIA Technical Delegate's Report N° 8, the Stewards received a subsequent report from the FIA Technical Delegate explaining that there was actually no breach of Article 25.12 of 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations. The Stewards considered that this subsequent report is a significant and relevant new element which was unavailable to them at the time of their Decision N° 12.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
