The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, heard from the Competitors' Representatives and the Drivers concerned, having examined (video) evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Fact: Alleged causing a collision with car 7 at Turn 5.
Offence: Alleged Breach of Article 16.1 d) of 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations
Decision: No further action
Reason: The Stewards determined that the collision between car 13 and car 7 is the result of several unfortunate elements. Indeed, the driver of car 37 started a manoeuvre to overtake Car 13 on the inside. Nearly simultaneously, the driver of car 13 started a manoeuvre to overtake car 33. By doing so, he moved to the right leaving little space to the driver of car 37 who was already committed to his overtaking manoeuvre. Car 13 and car 37 had a small contact that contributed to the collision between car 13 and car 7, but which is considered by the Stewards as too minor to warrant an investigation. When it comes to car 7, the driver mentioned during the hearing that he took a slightly tighter line than normal to get a better exit. The Stewards consider that the driver of car 7 was entitled to do so, but this is an element which also contributed to the situation and that is important for the full picture. In light of all these elements, the Stewards consider this incident as a racing incident.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
