The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined (video) evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 16 / Sébastien Buemi
Competitor: Envision Racing
Session: Qualifying - Group A
Time (fact): 09:46
Fact: Causing a collision dangerously with car 48 at Turn 13
Offence: Breach of Article 16.1 d) of 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations
Decision: Drop of 5 grid positions for the next Race in which the Driver takes part (2 penalty points awarded, 4 in total)
Reason: Having reviewed the video evidence and analysed the data from both cars, the stewards determined that Car 16 was on a preparation lap and was attempting to begin a push lap on exit of Turn 13. Car 48 was approaching Turn 13 on a push lap and, upon reaching the apex, encountered Car 16 which was returning on the racing line. The driver of Car 48 had no reasonable opportunity to slow the car and consequently made contact with Car 16.

After extensive consideration, the stewards concluded that the driver of Car 16 was driving in a dangerous manner and was wholly responsible for the collision between the two cars. Accordingly, the stewards imposed a five-place grid penalty and two penalty points.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
