



FIA FORMULA E WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND 9&10 - MONACO E-PRIX 14 - 17 MAY 2026

The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Sporting Delegate, heard from the Competitors' Representative and Mr. Kaashif Rushdan (Social Media Manager), having examined photo evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Competitor: DS PENSKE

Session: Before Free Practice 1

Time (fact): 06:34

Fact: During the "Full Scale Track Test" before Free Practice 1 a staff member of DS PENSKE entered the track at Turn 1 and walked along the track up to the Pit Lane Entry while the circuit was live and the Safety Car was circulating.

Offence: Breach of Article 12.2.1.h of the FIA International Sporting Code, Article 30.24 and Appendix 6 of the 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations.

Decision: Fine of 1.500 € and withdrawal of Mr. Rushdan's Purple Pass for the remainder of the Monaco Competition.

Reason: The Stewards heard from the Team Representative and Mr. Kaashif Rushdan (Social Media Manager) and examined the report from the Sporting Delegate.

It is undisputed that Mr. Rushdan, holder of a Purple Pass issued for non-operational personnel, entered the track at Turn 1 and walked along the circuit up to the Pit Lane Entry during the "Full Scale Track Test", at a time when the circuit was live and the Safety Car was circulating. Appendix 6 of the FIA Formula E Sporting Regulations clearly limits holders of Purple Passes to non-live operational areas. By entering and walking on the live track, Mr. Rushdan clearly acted outside the scope of the access rights granted by his accreditation. The Stewards acknowledge the apologies offered by both the Team Representative and Mr. Rushdan and note Mr. Rushdan's explanation that a security person may have incorrectly directed him towards that route. However, the Stewards consider that this does not relieve either the Competitor or Mr. Rushdan of their responsibility to comply with the applicable accreditation and safety rules, particularly given that Mr. Rushdan is an experienced team staff member who has attended FIA Formula E events for several years and should therefore have been aware that entering a live track was not permitted. The Stewards further note that, according to the official timetable, the track closing lap took place at 06h20, whereas the incident occurred at 06h34, at a time when it should have been clearly apparent that the circuit was already live and that access to the track was no longer permitted. The Stewards therefore do not consider this to be a marginal infringement. The Stewards consider that entering a live circuit clearly constitutes an unsafe act resulting in an unsafe situation within the meaning of Article 12.2.1.h of the FIA International Sporting Code. Accordingly, the Stewards order the withdrawal of Mr. Rushdan's Purple Pass for the remainder of the Monaco Competition and impose a fine of EUR 1,500 on the Competitor.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
