The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined (video) evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 13 / Antonio Felix Da Costa

Competitor: Jaguar TCS Racing

Session: Race

Time (fact): 15:48

Fact: Alleged not following the Race Directors instructions in the T10-11 Chicane.

Offence: Alleged Breach of Article 12.2.1.i of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code in conjunction with point 7.4 of the Drivers Briefing Notes.

Decision: No further action

Reason: Car 13 passed through the run-off area at Turns 10 and 11 without coming to a complete stop before rejoining the track, as required by Article 7.4 of the Drivers Briefing Notes. However, after reviewing the circumstances of the incident, the Stewards determined that Car 13 had been forced off the track by another car and that the shortcut through the chicane was not the result of any error of judgement by the driver of Car 13. The Stewards therefore consider that the exception foreseen in Article 7.5 of the Drivers Briefing Notes applies in this case and accordingly decide that no further action is warranted.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
