The Stewards having received a report from the FIA Pitlane Delegate, heard from the team representative, having considered the matter, determine the following

Competitor: CUPRA KIRO
Session: Saturday 16.05.2026
Time (fact): 17:26
Fact: Mrs. Bianca Bustamante had not been declared by the Competitor in the operational staff declaration submitted to the FIA for the Monaco E-Prix.
Offence: Breach of Article 27.5 of the 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations.
Decision: Fine of 1.000 €
Reason: The Stewards heard from the Team Representative and examined the report from the Pit Lane Delegate. The Stewards acknowledge the explanation provided by the Team Representative that the omission resulted from a human error, whereby the relevant staff member had completed the required submission on the Formula E portal but failed to complete the corresponding declaration on the FIA portal. The Team Representative apologised for the oversight and accepted that the declaration required under Article 27.5 of the Sporting Regulations had not been properly completed within the prescribed timeframe. While the Stewards accept that the omission was not intentional, the requirement to submit complete and accurate operational staff declarations is an important element of the operational control procedures of the Championship. The Stewards therefore determine that the Competitor breached Article 27.5 and elect to impose a fine of EUR 1,000 on the Competitor.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
