The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined (video) evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 27 / Jake Dennis
Competitor: Andretti Formula E
Session: Race
Time (fact): 15:44
Fact: Car 27 caused a collision with Car 33 at the exit of Turn 6.
Offence: Breach of Article 16.1 d) of the 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations.
Decision: 5 Second Time Penalty (1 penalty point awarded, 2 in total)
Reason: The Stewards examined video evidence and in-car video evidence. At the exit of Turn 6, Car 33 was overtaking Car 27 on the outside. In accordance with the Driving Standards Guidelines for overtaking on the outside of a corner, Car 33 had its front axle ahead of the front axle of Car 27 at the apex and executed the manoeuvre in a controlled manner. Car 27 failed to leave sufficient racing room at corner exit, resulting in contact between the two cars and damage to the front right of Car 33. The Stewards therefore determine that Car 27 was wholly responsible for the collision with Car 33 and elect to impose a 5 second time penalty and 1 penalty point.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
