The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined (video) evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Competitor: MAHINDRA RACING
Session: Race
Time (fact): 15:06
Fact: Car 48 caused a collision with Car 13 in Turn 10-11 Chicane.
Offence: Breach of Article 16.1 d) of the 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations.
Decision: 10 Second Time Penalty (1 penalty point awarded, 3 in total)
Reason: The Stewards examined video evidence & in-car video evidence. In Turn 10, Car 48 was closely following Car 13. Prior to and at the apex, Car 48 had not established any overlap with Car 13. Shortly after the apex of Turn 10, Car 48 made two contacts with the rear of Car 13, first a small contact and then a bigger hit resulting in a spin for Car 13. The Stewards determine that Car 48 failed to avoid contact with the car ahead and was wholly responsible for the collision with Car 13. Although Car 25 was in very close proximity, we don't assess him to have impacted the incident between Cars 48 & 13, even though there was also a contact between 25 and 48, this happened fractions of a second after the hit from Car 48 to Car 13. Accordingly, the Stewards elect to impose a 10 second time penalty and 1 penalty point.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
