The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined (video) evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 7 / Maximilian Günther

Competitor: DS PENSKE

Session: Race

Time (fact): 15:20

Fact: Car 7 caused a collision with Car 16 in Turn 6.

Offence: Breach of Article 16.1 d) of the 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations.

Decision: 5 Second Time Penalty (1 penalty point awarded, 5 in total)

Reason: The Stewards examined video evidence and in-car video evidence. At Turn 6, Car 7 attempted to overtake Car 16 on the inside and made contact with Car 16 near the apex of the corner. The Stewards note that, while Car 7 may have reached the level of the mirror of Car 16 at the apex itself, Car 7 had not established the required overlap sufficiently prior to the apex, as required by the Driving Standards Guidelines for overtaking on the inside of a corner. The Stewards acknowledge that Car 16 adopted a tighter line towards the apex than the normal racing line and could reasonably have been aware of the presence of Car 7 on the inside.

However, notwithstanding this, the Stewards determine that the predominant responsibility for the collision still rests with Car 7, as the overtaking manoeuvre did not satisfy all the requirements set out in the Driving Standards Guidelines. Accordingly, the Stewards determine that Car 7 caused the collision with Car 16 and elect to impose a 5 second time penalty and 1 penalty point.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 13.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
