The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined (video) evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 14 / Joel Eriksson
Competitor: Envision Racing
Session: Free Practice 1
Time (fact): 16:34
Fact: Alleged wheelspinning in the pitlane
Offence: Alleged breach of Article 23.18 of 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations
Decision: No further action
Reason: The Stewards reviewed telemetry and broadcast and onboard video.

The telemetry showed that the wheel speed on Car 14 momentarily exceeded its GPS speed by a significant margin thereby indicating a loss of traction (burnout). However, the video evidence showed that the incident occurred before the rear wheels of Car 14 crossed from the garage exit into the working lane. As the garage does not form part of the Pit Lane as defined in Article 5(a) of Chapter IV Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, the Stewards determined that no breach was established and for that reason took no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
