The Stewards have considered the matter and determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and thus impose the penalty referred to below.

N° / Driver: 23 / Norman Nato
Competitor: Nissan Formula E Team
Session: Before Race
Fact: The Competitor is not able to serve all the grid place penalties received refer to Stewards Decision 1 at the Shanghai E-Prix.
Offence: Application of Article 28.11 of 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations
Decision: 10-second stop-and-go time penalty during the next race in which the driver takes part.
Reason: The E-Motor (MGU) and 2 gearboxes were changed on Car 23 before Free Practice 1 of the Shanghai E-Prix.

Since the car is not able to serve all 60 grid places on the Starting Grid imposed by Decision 1 of the Shanghai E-Prix, a penalty under Article 28.11 will be applied (10-second stop-and-go time penalty during the next race in which he takes part).

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
