The Stewards heard from the drivers of Car 25 and Car 48, as well as the relevant team representatives. They reviewed the available video footage, timing data and all other evidence presented.

Fact: Car 48 caused a collision with Car 25 at Turn 7.
Offence: Breach of Article 16.1 d) of 2025/2026 FIA Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations and App. L Chapter 4, Art. 2 d) ISC
Decision: 5 Second Time Penalty (1 penalty point awarded, 3 in total)
Reason: The Stewards summoned and heard from the Drivers of Cars 48 and 25 and their Team Representatives and reviewed video and onboard video, telemetry and GPS positioning data.

Car 48 moved to overtake Car 25 on the inside at turn 7. Just prior to the apex, Car 48 had a small oversteer event and as a consequence there was side to side contact with Car 25. Car 25 lost the position to Car 48 as a result.

The Driver of Car 48 said that he felt that Car 25 had not left him sufficient space on the inside and the oversteer event was caused by him having to put a tyre on the slippery white track edge line as a result. The Driver of Car 25 maintained that he had left more than a car width.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the Driver of Car 48 was predominantly to blame for the collision. Onboard vision from a following car confirmed that Car 48 was left a car width space on the inside. Accordingly, the Stewards imposed a 5 second time penalty on Car 48.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
