The Stewards having received a report from the Race Director regarding Car 11 and Car 25 and determined to conduct a broader investigation on their own initiative.

Decision: No further action
Reason: The Stewards summoned and heard from the Driver and his Authorised Representatives and viewed video, onboard video, GPS positioning data, timing data and telemetry.

On Lap 23 of the race Car 22 suffered a mechanical failure and stopped on the start finish straight adjacent to the barrier on drivers' right just prior to the control line. A Single Yellow flag signal was displayed at the light panels from turn 10 to the light panel just past the stopped car which was green. A short time later the light panel on drivers' left at the exit of turn 12 changed to Double Yellow which created a short Double Yellow mini sector which commenced after the apex of turn 12 and ended at the control line. That mini sector was subject to Double Yellow flags when Car 25 passed Car 22.

An analysis of the telemetry from Car 25 showed that when Car 25 was in the Double Yellow mini sector and prior to passing the stranded Car 22, the Driver of Car 25 braked momentarily (twice) and lifted off throttle and reduced speed. The Stewards determined that the brake, lift and speed reduction were sufficient and for that reason took no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
